Cotton Candy Machine Instructions

Operating Info:

Parts: 1 - Bubble, 1 - Floss Pan, 1 - Mesh Pan Liner, 5 - Clips for Mesh Net and 1 - Instructions **Power Requirements: DO NOT USE EXTENSION CORDS!** Grounded 15 Amp; 120V AC Circuit.

Switches:

Master/Power Switch - Turns machine on/off. **Candy Switch -** Turns on/off the Heating Element.

Operating Instructions:

- 1) Plug machine into its own standard 15amp outlet. (Machine will need 1 15amp circuit)
- 2) Do not use an extension cord! Unless one(1) is provided with the machine.
- **3)** Lower the handle down and place the Floss Pan on top of the Machine. Wrap the mesh netting around the inside of the floss pan and use the 5 clips to hold it in place against the pan.
- 4) Pour floss sugar in the Floss Head(center opening) of the cotton candy machine.
- 5) Check to make sure the leather strips are sticking straight out.
- 6) Safety First! Place the bubble on top of the floss pan to avoid possible injury.
- **7)** Completely turn off the machine everytime you add additional Floss Sugar or remove built up cotton candy around the Floss Head.
- **10)** Turn off the **Candy switch** when you are finished and wait for the machine to complete the cool down process (Note: The cool down light will turn on during this process) and shut off on its own.
- **11)** Return handle to the upright position for transportation and carrying.
- **12)** Empty out extra Floss sugar from the Floss Head into a bowl or trash can prior to returning the machine.
- 13) Do Not attempt to submerse or spray water on or near any part of this machine!
