Hot Dog Roller Grill Instructions

Operating Info:

Parts: 1 - Removable drip tray

Power Requirements:

DO NOT USE EXTENSION CORDS! Grounded 15 Amp; 120V AC Circuit.

Capacity: Aprox. 25-35 standard hot dogs depending on the unit.

Approximate cooking time is around 5+/- minutes.

Switches: Power Switch (Front and Rear) - Turns on heat to Cooking Surface

Heat Control Knob - Each knob controls the heat for a set of 5 rollers.

Operating Instructions:

- 1) Place the Hot Dog Roller Grill on a level surface.
- 2) Plug machine into its own standard 15amp outlet. (Machine will need 1 15amp circuit)
- 3) Do not use an extension cord! Other than what may be provided.
- 4) Place hot dogs on rollers.
- **5)** Turn on Power switch, Adjust heat control knob to the desired setting. The unit is designed with 2 seperate cooking zones. one knob will control the front half (set of 5 rollers) and the other knob will control the rear half (set of 5 rollers) of the cooking surface.
- **6)** For Low heat, set control(s) to LOW using one or both sets of rollers. For High heat, set controls to MEDIUM or HIGH using both sets of rollers
- **7)** Turn off all switches when you are finished.

Cleaning Instructions: Do not use steel wool to clean!

- 1) Unplug the unit
- 2) Remove the remaining hot dogs
- 3) Remove and wash drip tray with mild detergent and warm water and reinsert it under the rollers
- 4) Grand Rental Station will thoroughly clean the machine once it is returned.
